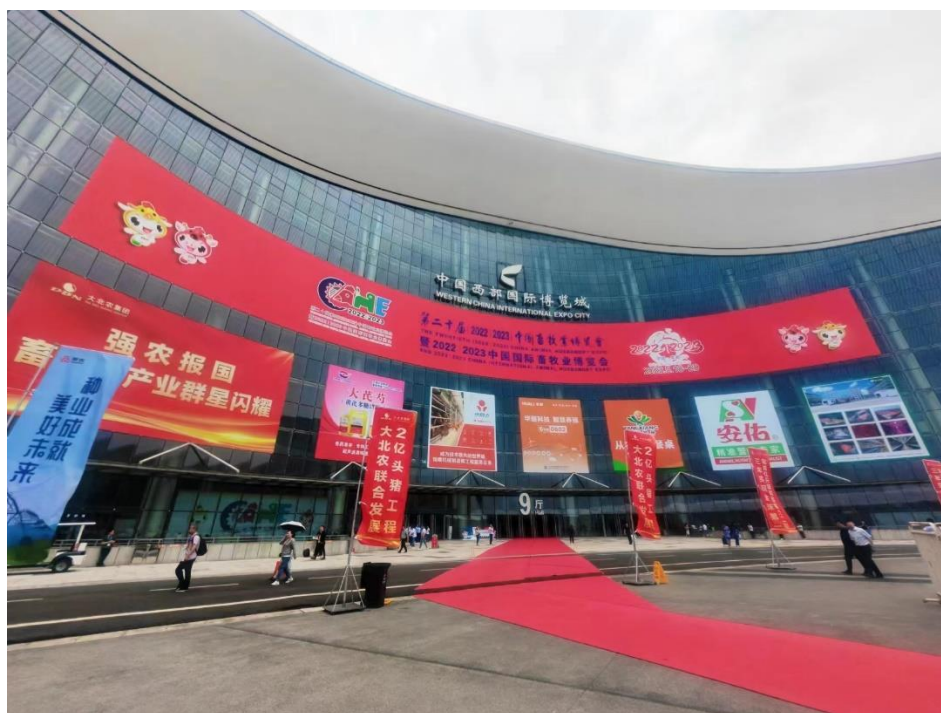
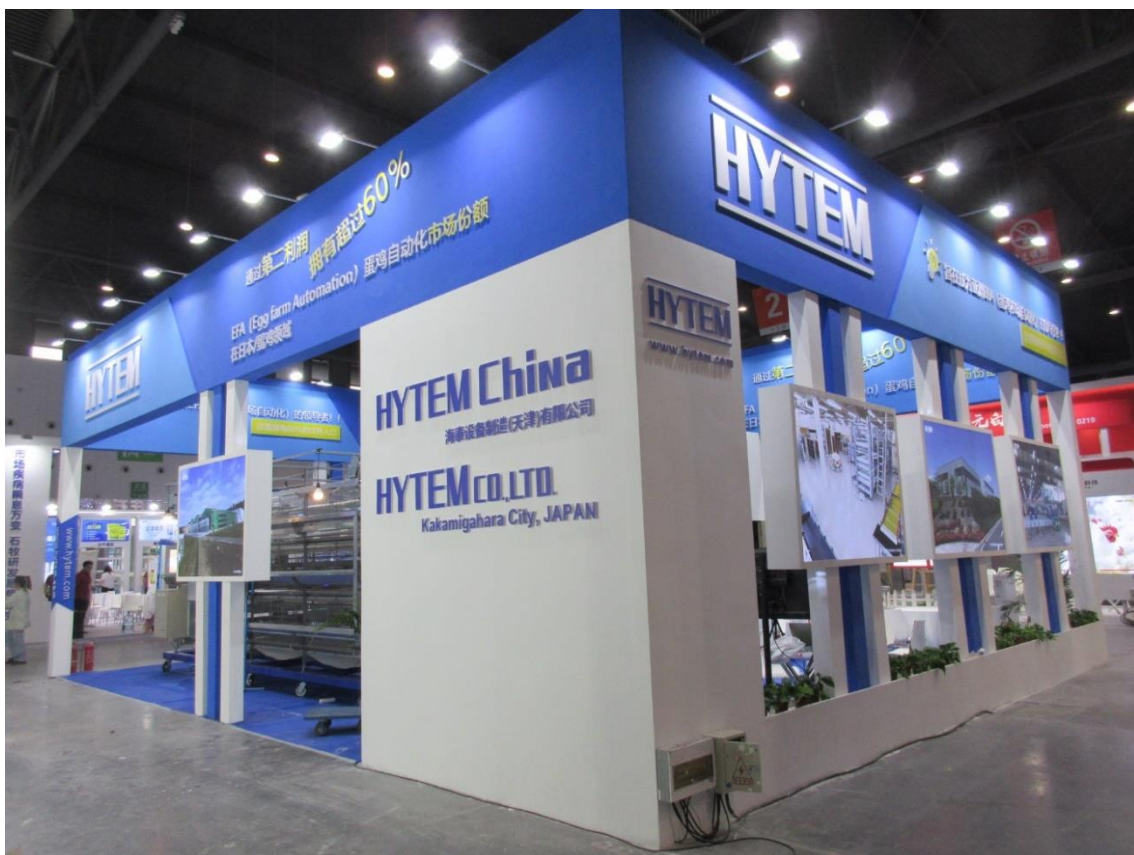


CAHE (China Animal Husbandry Expo)

In the background that the size of the poultry and livestock farms are becoming the bigger, and are being more automated in China, the scale of CAHE is growing. This year CAHE held May 18 - 20 in Chengdu City, the capital of Sichuan province was bigger than VIV Asia held in Bangkok last March, and more or less the same scale as Euro Tier and VIV Europe.

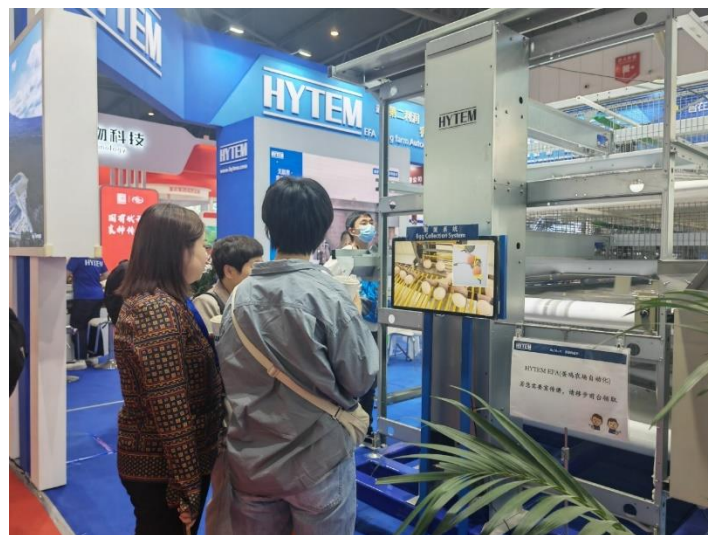


HYTEM booth renovated at this time CAHE.

The outstanding features were introduced by four individual screens, "Headache of Layer house Rats & Vermin Shutting out system", "No Egg Crack in Collection", "Manure Handling" and "Feeding System". Especially "Headache of Layer house Rats & Vermin Shutting out system" drew high attention, and have generated important new inquiries.

In China EFA market, Chinese and EU manufacturers are joining in fight. HYTEM is promoting EFA, emphasizing Profit No.2 coming from less running cost such as the least electrical consumption and the better feed consumption shutting out rats & vermin, and Profit No.3 coming from the smooth EFA running supported by the quick after sales. The secret of Profit No.2 & 3 is coming from the fact that egg demand is constantly existed during EFA life which is more than 20 years in the normal climate.

Offering Profit No.2 & 3, the amount of which has a potential more than EFA investment during the EFA life, at least, more than the price difference against our competitors trying to sell EFA by prices, HYTEM is targeting 10% China EFA market share (100% volume in Japan) focusing progressive egg farms, in the background of 60% plus market share in Japan, Egg Kingdom in the world (The highest egg safety and quality edible without cooking and 340 eggs per capita yearly consumption).
